Science lab sessions added excitement, whether it was creating a food chart, experimenting with sense organs, or crafting a paper fan to understand air movement. Each of these moments blended creativity with learning, making the classroom a lively place of discovery.

One of the highlights of the month was the Independence Day celebration. Our young learners proudly created the national flag using rice, masoor dal, moong, and brown rice for the flagpole. Their little hands worked with such care, and the result was a beautiful symbol of patriotism crafted with love. The celebration was filled with songs, stories, and a sense of pride that made the day truly special for both students and teachers.

August reminded us that learning is not just about lessons and tests but about nurturing joy, confidence, and curiosity in every child.
