Our Environmental Studies lessons were equally enriching. The children explored plant adaptations and the fascinating role of leaves as the "food factories" of plants. Hands-on science lab activities, including drawing and labeling plant parts and experimenting with models, made learning interactive and memorable. In Social Studies, journeys through India's landscapes—the northern mountains, western deserts, and southern plateaus—helped children connect geography to culture, while Hindi and Telugu classes nurtured expression through stories, poems, and oral recitations. Language learning was reinforced with reading tests, spelling activities, and vocabulary building, all of which strengthened confidence in both mother tongue and second languages.

Beyond academics, August was filled with moments of creativity and celebration. The Independence Day assembly was a highlight, where students expressed their patriotism through songs, speeches, and colorful displays. 

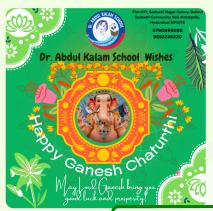
