Explaining about skeletal and muscular system.


Students at Dr. Abdul Kalam School explored the skeletal and muscular system through engaging explanations.





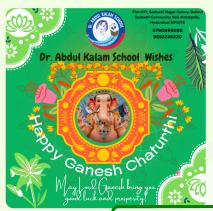
